English

This term, a range of book & Film studies will form our writing lessons, giving opportunities to write through narrative and non-fiction genres.

Reading Comprehension skills will be covered so children develop their understanding of the 6 key reading domains in discreet weekly lessons. We are reading...

Maths

We will be busy learning about the following themes in maths:

- Multiplication and division
- Length and perimeter
- Fractions
- Mass and capacity

R.E

<u>Christmas</u> - In this unit the story of the shepherds provides a focus for children to reflect on the birth of Jesus Christ and who he is.

<u>Reconciliation</u> - Children will explore human choices, the consequences of sin, Christ's teaching on forgiveness and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

<u>Lent</u> – Lent is a time when Catholics resolve to change to become more like Christ. In this new topic children will be introduced to new Gospel stories about Jesus bringing change into the lives of the people he encountered.

<u>Holy Week</u> – The children will deepen their knowledge of the events of Holy Week and deepen their understanding of the Church's celebration of the Mass.

Geography & History

In Geography we will be looking at, Rocks relics and rumbles. This project will aim to teach the children about features and characteristics of the Earth's layers. We will also look at Volcanic tectonic and seismic activity in detail.

Science

In science we will look at forces and magnets, this will teach the children about contact and non-contact forces, including friction and magnetism. We will investigate frictional and magnetic forces and identify parts of a magnet and magnetic materials.

In RSHE we will be looking at the unit Created to love others. Children will explore the individual relationships we have with others.

We continue to do lots in $Art \neq DT$ with projects such as make it move, people and places and ammonite.

In make it move the Children will experiment with different shaped Cams before designing, making and evaluating a Child's automaton toy.

In people and places, we will study figure drawings and urban landsCapes and look at the artist LS Lowry.

Finally in the project ammonite we will look at artistic techniques used in sketching, printmaking and sculpting.
