CL

Enrich vocabulary and experience of grammar in daily stories, rhymes and song.

Continue to develop back and forth conversation skills.

Grow vocabulary through focussed role play eg: naming objects and processes in kitchen stir, mix, sieve etc

Birthday books!

On your birthday you can bring in your favourite story and we can read it to everyone!

PD

GMS: build strength and fluency of large body movements by lifting, carrying, navigating obstacles, climbing up, down and over.

FMS: daily experiences of malleable materials, focussed hand strength activities, mark making resources.

R.E

Christmas-explore the Crib and recall some of the characters and events relating to our Nativity play.

Discuss what a celebration is and share ways that the children may celebrate important events at home.

Lent- discuss ways that we prepare ready for an event/célébration

Explore reflection and silence!

PSED

Promote, through modelling, prompting and celebrating-care for others- listening and sharing.

Inspire a sense of responsibility and respect for resources eg: putting lids on pens, tidying up etc.

Support independence in self care and routines offering prompts and scaffolding as appropriate. Continue to develop organisational skills.

Maths

Sorting – opportunities to sort objects according to various criteria- size, shape, colour and discuss.

Patterns- observe and make patterns using positional and shape language to describe.

Begin to record number related ideas- I am drawing the apples that the caterpillar ate through.

Art

Experience a variety of mark making techniques- finger painting, printing, scribbling, scratching, modelling etc.

Explore a range of mark making media- paint, pastels, chalks.

Talk about colours and explore colour choices for different tasks.

Music- listen to a range of instruments played live. Enjoy playing percussion to accompany singing and movement. Continue to explore own voice- whisper, sing

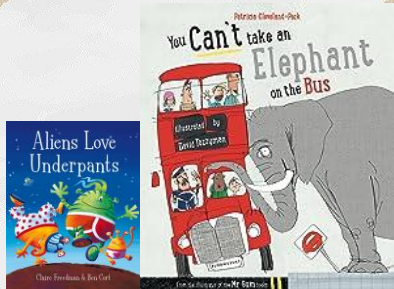
Enrichment
