


EAD

Maths



Continue to learn a range of Number rhymes and songs. Count by rote, represent numbers on fingers. Develop language of shape and measure.

Role play

Use talk to organise themselves and others in play. Take on a role in simple pretend play. Begin to develop complex stories with small world sets.

EAD

Art Markmaking on big paper with variety of media. Using paints to make prints. Create patterns with natural materials. Draw with extra detail and complexity.
