

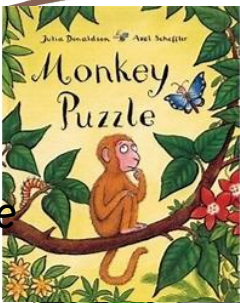
# Autumn Term in Nursery

### Communication and Language

Daily storytimes and chatting time  
Wellcom Language Screening for each child will give us next steps to work on in daily conversation.  
Enjoy listening to longer stories.  
Pay attention to more than one thing at a time.  
Use a wider range of vocabulary.  
Understand an instruction with two parts.

### Physical Development

Continue to develop their movement and balance.  
Use large muscle movements to wave streamers and make marks.  
Show preference for a dominant hand.  
Make healthy choices about food, drinks and toothbrushing.

Learn about our class saint St Nicholas  
Through story and song gain an awareness of God.  
Join in with simple prayer time.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Select activities and resources with help if necessary.  
Develop their sense of community and responsibility.  
Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people in the safe context of their new setting.

### Maths

Develop fast recognition of up to 3+ objects (subitising)

Recite numbers past 5

Say one number for each item in order 1,2,3,4,5

Explore 2D and 3D shapes using simple language

sides/straight/round

## L

### Literacy

Develop their phonological awareness

Spot and suggest rhymes

Count and Clap syllables in a word

Recognise words with same initial sound.

Enjoy a rich variety of stories

## UW

### Understanding the World

Use all their senses in hands on exploration.

Talk about changes that we notice in the garden and weather.

Talk about what they see using a widening vocabulary.

Begin to make sense of their own life story.

## EAD Art/drama

### Art

Take part in simple role play.

Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects.

## EAD Music

### Music

Sing Nursery Rhymes

Join in with singing whole songs.

Listen to some live instruments.

Start to move to the beat and respond to music with movement.

Start to improvise with voices whispering/singing
